Awana Conference

We are excited this year to once again offer a live Awana Conference. We will not be participating in the simulcast training. Please realize that information and workshops that are listed about conference on the national Awana website are for the simulcast only.

Due to popular demand, we are expanding the Saturday session this year. There will be 3 workshops in the morning, and practical sessions for all club leadership in the afternoon.

Things You Need to Know

1. **Know the Registration Deadline** – There will be no exceptions! Registrations cannot be made by phone, fax, email, or web.
2. **Meal** – We will not be providing meals at either the Friday or Saturday session. We will be taking a break for lunch on Saturday for you to go to a close fast food location.
3. The Awana conference will be **both** Friday evening and Saturday morning. The conference is designed to be a 9 hour conference (3 hr. Fri, 6 hr. Sat.)
4. If you or your leaders are only able to attend one session, we would still encourage you to come.
5. There will be **one set cost** to the entire conference. The cost will be the same if you attend just Fri. night, just Sat., or both Fri. and Sat.
6. **Basic Training** will be offered at the conference. Trainees must attend both Friday & Saturday to complete the Basic Training.

How to Get People to Come?

1. **Encourage your pastor to attend.** He will be the greatest encouragement to your leadership!
2. **Publicize it frequently** – from the pulpit, in the bulletin, via emails, phone calls, etc.
3. **Contact every one personally** – ask them very specifically if they will be going.
4. **Work for 100% attendance** – explain that it is the best way to begin the club year.
5. **Don't give leaders a choice** – expect them to go. Allow very few excuses.
6. **Tell leaders when you recruit them** that the conference is part of the job.
7. **Have them come to be examples to others, just as you plan to do!**



Ministry Support Needs

As many of you know, we as Awana Missionaries are faith supported missionaries. The finances for our personal monthly expenses, and the monthly ministry expenses come from our supporters. We do not receive money from Awana Headquarters each month. The only money we receive is from churches or individuals that support us.
